

EMANUEL COUNTY HEIFER SHOW RULES – OCTOBER 3, 2006

General Rules

1. All heifer entries must show proper Ga. Health papers signed by a veterinarian prior to unloading.
2. Purebred heifer entries must be subject to registration. This should be verified by the appropriate agent or teacher.
3. All animals must be classified immediately upon arrival. Number of classes will be determined by number of entries.
4. All animals must be in the possession of the exhibitor by **September 1** of this year. Any exceptions will not be allowed to compete for premium.
5. Exhibitors that are younger than 4-H or FFA age will be allowed to compete, but the animal must be shown by the exhibitor. All other exhibitors must be bona-fide club members.
6. The sponsor of the show will not be responsible for loss or damage to an exhibit, but will give care and attention to prevent loss or damage to any exhibitor.
7. When there is no competition in an established class, first place ribbons and second place prize money will be awarded.
8. No more than two heifers can be entered per class by an exhibitor or no more than three heifers in the entire show. County agent, or Vo-Ag teacher and parent must sign entry form.
9. Exhibitor must show own animal unless the exhibitor has more than one animal in the same class. Substitute showmen must be a 4-H or FFA boy or girl or younger.
- 10. Animals should arrive between 8:00am and 12:00 noon on Tuesday, October 3th 2006.**
- 11. A \$10.00 entry fee per animal should be paid when the entry form is sent in.** Please make check payable to Emanuel County 4-H. Please mail entry form and check to: Mark Crosby, Emanuel County Extension Service, P. O. Box 770, Swainsboro, Georgia 30401.
- 12. On show date the exhibitor and one parent will be allowed to enter the fair gate without being charged admission. The Swainsboro Jaycees have asked each County Agent and Ag Teacher to make all of their exhibitors aware of this ruling. The Jaycees will have someone at the back gate.**
- 13. AGE CLASSIFICATIONS**

Established classes in which prizes will be awarded will consist of at least 4 heifers or more with registration papers. If purebred heifers do not have registration papers, they will be put in the commercial class. Less than 4 heifers (purebred and registration papers) will be put in other breeds.

SR. HEIFER CALVES - Calved between Sept. 1 and Dec. 31 of 2005

SUMMER YEARLING HEIFER - Calved between May 1 and Aug. 31 of 2005

JR. YEARLING HEIFER - Calved between Jan. 1 and April 30 of 2005

SR. YEARLING HEIFER - Calved between Sept. 1 and Dec. 31 of 2004

2-YEAR OLD HEIFER - Calved between May 1 and August 31 of 2004

PREMIUMS: 1st \$25.00; 2nd \$20.00; 3rd \$15.00; 4th \$10.00 5th \$5.00

GRAND CHAMPION: Trophy or Plaque and \$25.00

RESERVE CHAMPION: Trophy or Plaque and \$20.00
