

LIVESTOCK RULES - SWINE SHOW
SOUTHEAST GA. JAYCEE FAIR
2006

1. All livestock must be disease-free to be entered in the fair.
 - A. Swine
 1. Breeding swine six (6) months of age and older must test negative to an official brucellosis and pseudo rabies test within 30 days prior to date of exhibition.
 - B. All exhibitors must have health papers in their possession before unloading livestock. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
2. All official entry forms must be in the hands of the show chairman by **Friday, September 1, 2006.**

4. **All livestock must be brought in on Wednesday, October 4th from 2:00 P.M. to 6:00 P.M.**
5. Livestock will be fed and watered by the show committee. Please bring a feed container. They will not be fed or watered after lunch on Thursday.
6. The show will be held on **Thursday, October 5, 2005 at 6:30 P.M.**
7. The animals may be removed immediately after the show but not before show is over.
8. All hogs entered must have been owned by and in the possession of the exhibitor by September 1.
9. ***Each exhibitor is limited to showing up to 2 pigs in 2006.***
10. ***The first 100 gilts entered are guaranteed a space in the show. Any entries received above and beyond 100 may be accepted if space is available.***
11. Each animal must be identified so that it can be determined from the entry form who is showing the animal.
12. Registration papers will be checked upon arrival.
13. All purebred breeds of swine will be eligible to show. ***This year we have added a class of commercial gilts to the show.***
14. There must be six (6) gilts of a breed to make a class. If there are not six, they will be shown as other breeds.
15. There must be two first place hogs in a breed before a champion and reserve champion will be selected.
16. When there is only one hog in a class, ribbons and money will be awarded at judge's discretion.
17. No more than one hog per class per exhibitor.
18. Hogs will be accepted from counties in the Vocational Agriculture Education Central Region, Area IV first.
19. The decision of the judge will be final.
20. Conflict of rules will be settled by hog show manager.
21. The fair association does everything it can to protect and care for the livestock, but in no case will it be responsible for loss or damage that may occur to them.
22. Only bona fide FFA or 4-H members may show hogs as well as those in pre-club (Pre-club members are students in Pre-K through 4th grade)

23. On show date the exhibitor and one parent will be allowed to enter the fair gate without being charged admission. The Swainsboro Jaycees have asked each County Agent and Ag Teacher to make all of their exhibitors aware of this ruling. The Jaycees will have someone at the back gate.
24. Please be prepared to have animals three to a pen.

Trophies or plaques will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in Pre-club, 5-7th grade, 8-10th grade, and 11-12th grade Showmanship classes.

22. Showmanship will be divided into four (4) groups: pre-club (4th grade and under); 5-7th grade; 8- 10th grade; and 11- 12th grade. **Note: Showmanship will begin with Senior Showmanship and end with Pre-club Showmanship.**
